Post Treatment Care

Having a perfect smile is very exciting, and thanks to the use of a dental bridge, crowns, or veneers, the natural look and regular functions of your teeth will be restored. Once the procedure is completed and your bridges/crowns have been cemented, it's **totally normal to feel discomfort**.



Although your new crowns, veneers, or bridges might look as natural teeth, **you'll** need a few days to get used to them.



You must keep your mouth clean **to prevent bacteria and/or an infection.** Brush the treated area **very gently** with a **soft toothbrush**; you can wash the soft toothbrush with hot water to soften the bristles and begin flossing. **After 1 week**, you can gently and gradually return to normal brushing.



If after your treatment you feel that your bite is not correctly balanced, **please give us** a **call as soon as possible** to make an appointment for the adjustments.

In case you are going home with **temporary bridges or crowns**, it is necessary to return to our clinic within **one month** to finish the treatment and place the permanent devices.
